

INVESTIGATOR LIABILITY

This form will be read and signed by all investigators. This pertains to long-term members, members who participate occasionally, and someone whom only participates in a single investigation. It is the responsibility for every member and person participating in any investigation to maintaining a decent and professional manor during and away from investigations. Clients are our most valuable resource, and our purpose is to help our clients to the best of our abilities. Therefore, South Georgia Paranormal Association has to keep and maintain a professional image at all times. When a single member or participant produces an unprofessional image in front of a client or the public eye, it does not just reflect a bad image for the individual, but it reflects a bad image on the group as a whole. The bad image becomes associated with South Georgia Paranormal Association. So it is the duty of all members and participants to respect the image that South Georgia Paranormal Association is trying to maintain. There will be no fowl language used on any investigation, no horse playing, no sexual references, no negative attitudes, no abusive or degrading talk or actions towards any members, no rude behavior towards members or clients, no articles of clothing that portray any sexual or vulgar images, and no aggressive behavior of any kind. These actions will not be tolerated under any circumstances. South Georgia Paranormal Association has placed certain guidelines in place when it comes to our investigations. A game plan will be set for each investigation, and team leaders will be assigned. Team leaders will generally be the founder and co-founder unless stated otherwise. Every member or participant will follow the guidelines that their team leader specifies during each investigation. Investigations are to be taken seriously at all times, and each member or participant should remain focused during the investigation. Assigned teams will take breaks periodically during the investigation. No foods or drinks will be allowed during the investigation phases unless temperature conditions demand that drinks be allowed. South Georgia Paranormal Association requires all members and participants during any investigation to respect and preserve client's properties. It should be every member and participants main priority not to cause damage to any items within or outside of the client's property. Do not touch or move any item that is not related directly to the investigation for any reason. During each investigation, our job is to gather information and evidence that might explain what the client is experiencing. It is extremely crucial that no equipment is tampered with any way that might falsify any evidence that is captured during an investigation. So it is important that every individual involved be mindful of their actions at all times. There will be no funny sounds, faint whispers, or anything similar to these actions that might cause a piece of evidence to be thrown out due to carelessness. Anyone caught deliberately trying to falsify evidence will be removed from the group immediately. All of the actions listed above will not be tolerated, and disciplinary actions, which may include suspension or termination, will be taken in order to preserve the integrity of South Georgia Paranormal Association. Last, but not least. No detailed information pertaining to the investigation should be brought to the attention of the client until all evidence has been reviewed. South Georgia Paranormal Association does not want to place false assumption in the mind of our clients, so it is important that all evidence is reviewed and analyzed before any detailed information about the case is revealed. This includes personal experiences during the investigation. It is okay to state that we had some interesting things happen, but be sure to add that we need to review and analyze our evidence before we make judgment.
